

Alcoa has released the Anglesea Mine Rehabilitation and Closure Plan for community feedback.

Following the permanent shut down of the Anglesea Power Station and Mine in August 2015, Alcoa has continued to actively engage with the community and key stakeholders about the future of its freehold and leasehold areas.

Alcoa has now prepared a Mine Rehabilitation & Closure Plan to meet its commitment to the community and regulatory obligations, and is seeking feedback ahead of the Plan's submission to the Victorian Government. The Plan, as illustrated, details the rehabilitation and the future land form of the area disturbed by mining. The area is predominantly leased land.

Features include a large water body, extensive rehabilitated areas, and proposed areas and access for future alternative uses.

The Plan is underpinned by key geotechnical, hydrological and vegetation technical studies undertaken by experienced consultants and independently peer reviewed where appropriate.

The Plan also considers the five guiding principles developed during Alcoa's broad community consultation in 2016, and reflective of the community's aspirations for the site:

- Provides a safe and stable landform for future uses
- Values and complements the natural environment
- Supports a diverse range of future uses and outcomes
- Honours the various cultural and heritage values of the area
- Complements the future of the Anglesea Region

It is envisaged rehabilitation will be managed by Alcoa over approximately the next ten years.

Alcoa welcomes feedback on the plan prior to its submission to the regulator, the Earth Resources Regulation of the Victorian Government's Department of Economic Development, Jobs, Transport and Resources.

The consultation period concludes on Sunday 25 June.

As part of Alcoa's ongoing commitment to community consultation, the community is invited to provide feedback on the Anglesea Mine Rehabilitation & Closure Plan.
